OUR SPEAKER

ROGER J. FROCK is one of the founders of Federal Express, having been associated with the company since it's early beginning in 1971. He conducted the initial Marketing and Economic Feasibility Studies in 1972 and was responsible for all direct line operations during start up of the concept in 1972 and 1973.

Prior to joining Federal Express, he spent 12 years as a principal with A. T. Kearney, management consultants in Chicago and New York City. During his career in consulting, he conducted numerous studies for many of the nation's leading motor carriers, shipping lines, railroads and airlines, as well as studies to improve distribution patterns for major industrial corporstions.

He currently is a Senior Vice President of Federal Express with overall responsibility for operating the Western Division.

Mr. Frock is a graduate of the University of Michigan with a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial Enginering and a Master's Degree in Business Administration.

In just 3 years he has seen Federal Express, which specializes in overnite, door-todoor transportation of small packages, grow to where it expects its revenues this year to exceed \$100 million. The first night three years ago it carried 15 packages; now it carries roughly 19,000 packages each night.
