We have 24 students at 5 major universities that are receiving our Scholarship support this budget year. Over the last 15 years our Foundation has provided over \$620,000.00 in funding.

These current students have majors in molecular biology, electrical engineering, bio-chemistry to business administration, sociology and even linguistics. These students carry an average Grade Point Average of 3.71 and five of them have a GPA greater than 3.90 including one who has a 3.99 and another with a 3.98.
