THE PROGRAM

There were no wedding bells or rice thrown when DOUG SCOVIL was named head football coach at San Diego State University last December. However, it's not too hard to see why the occasion could be considered a "marriage made in heaven". After all, the announcement had brought together a school that has become synonymous in college football circles with an innovative passing offense and a man who is acknowledged to be one of the best minds in the country when it comes to throwing the football.

DOUG SCOVIL is the ideal candidate to continue the aerial legacy of Don Corvell and Claude Gilbert that has made SDSU famous. The 49-year old Anacortes, Washington native comes to Montezuma Mesa with a wealth of major college and professional experience, most recently being four successful years as a top assistant at Brigham Young University. His 1979 BYII team broke 13 NCAA offensive records while the 1980 unit broke or tied 28 records, many of them previously held by San Diego State. The Cougars last year led the nation in passing, scoring and total offense, while their quarterback, Jim McMahon, became the first collegian at the 1-A level to surpass 4,000 yards in the air.

Mr. Scovil has coached at the Sacred Heart High School in San Francisco; College of San Mateo; U.S. Naval Academy under Wayne Hardin; University of the Pacific; San Franciso 49ers (they won three divisional titles during his time there); and the Chicago Bears. He coached twice in the Pro Bowl and was on the Senior Bowl staff in 1975.


