

THE PROGRAM

DR. ANDREW STRENK is a Professor of History at the University of Southern California and Academic Advisor to the College of Letters, Arts, and Sciences.

He earned his Bachelors degree in history at USC 1972 Phi Beta Kappa. His honors included USC Outstanding Scholar Athlete and Pacific Eight Conference Outstanding Scholar Athlete (1971). He was a member of the 1967 and 1971 Pan American, 1968 Olympic and 1967 and 1970 World Student Games USA swimming team. He was an NCAA and AAU All American in swimming and broke one world and five American records.

He earned his Masters degree in Soviet and Eastern European History at Julias Maximillians University in West Germany in 1975 and his PhD in Modern European History from USC in 1978.

Dr. Strenk served as a press officer to the 1978 World Swimming Championships in West Germany, and served as a journalist for Swimming World magazine covering the 1976 Olympics. He was a broadcaster for armed forces radio, covering swimming and track events at the 1972 Olympics in Munich.

He has published extensively in the field of sports and international relations and has developed a course which he teaches in the USC history department entitled "Sports and International Politics".


